uReach alternative provision

Since joining uReach in December 2025, our two pupils (Year 2 and Year 5) have benefitted enormously from the highly supportive and adaptable environment provided. Both pupils find a mainstream school environment extremely challenging and are currently awaiting specialist school placements as documented in their EHCPs. This provision has offered them a safe, structured, and nurturing setting that meets their individual needs.

Both pupils have already shown clear progress in their behaviour, both within the provision and when attending school. They are increasingly able to respond to adult requests and instructions and show greater readiness to accept adult support to co-regulate. This improvement has had a noticeable positive impact on their overall engagement and emotional wellbeing.

Communication with both parents and school has been excellent. The team are consistently proactive and responsive, ensuring incidents or difficulties are shared promptly and thoughtfully. Half-termly review meetings provide valuable updates on progress, next steps, and any emerging needs, enabling us to work collaboratively and effectively.

The activities offered are varied, engaging, and carefully adapted to each child's interests and strengths. This personalised approach has had a clear positive impact on the pupils' engagement and confidence.

In addition, the provision of transport has been a significant support to families, especially parents already managing substantial pressures. This practical help has ensured excellent attendance and reduced stress for all involved.

Overall, this alternative provision has demonstrated a highly professional, caring, and solution-focused approach, making a meaningful difference to the pupils' wellbeing and educational experience. We are extremely grateful for their continued support and commitment.
